



## Torre Primary School SEND at a glance 2023–2024

### Strengths of SEND in school -improvements made

- All pupils have an Individual learning plan, these are reviewed half termly and impact of provision/interventions are reviewed
- Collaborative working with outside agencies (SEND, AP, Safeguarding etc) ensures children get the right support at the right time
- Link with the MHST ensures children and families with mental health needs receive the support they need
- Reading is prioritised for all children and is streamlined throughout the whole school
- Our most vulnerable learners have impactful nurture and pastoral support sessions
- Section F interventions are led by the nurture/attachment lead and are impactful within the classroom environment
- Up-level LSA's with Lego Therapy interventions across all areas of the school

### To improve SEND our KEY priorities are ...

- Adaptive teaching – support from Educational Psychologist
- To further develop metacognitive strategies for all pupils with additional needs
- To use Provision Mapping Tool for costings and to ensure interventions result in sustained and rapid progress for pupils
- To ensure children with identified SALT needs are being supported in school pre-triage route
- All staff are re-trained with PACE and restorative practice training guidance
